Marie used to be a hairdresser, and still likes to look her best. She is proud her mother was a nurse and her father worked for the railroad.

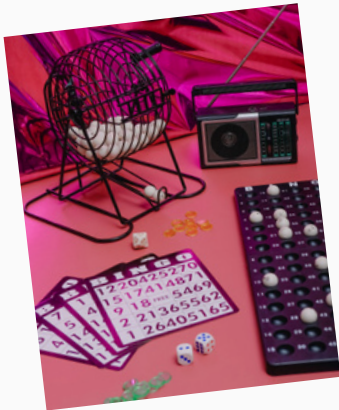

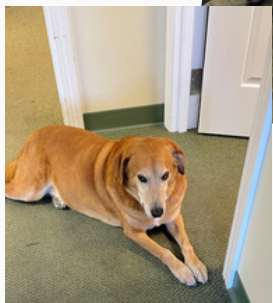

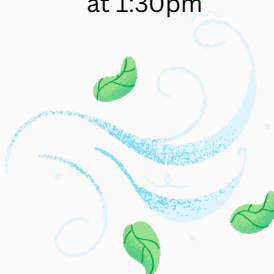

While her husband was in the war, Mabel worked as a welder . She welded on ships and anchors.

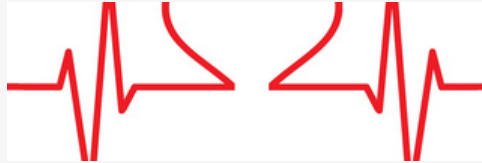

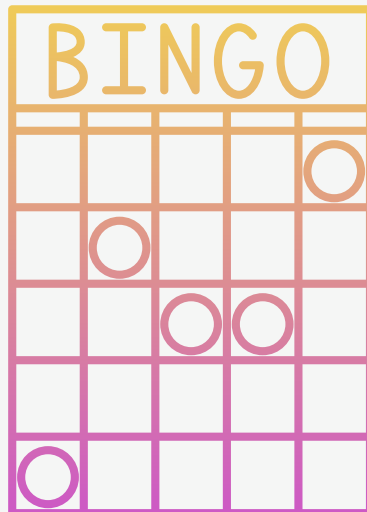

either walking or planting flowers.

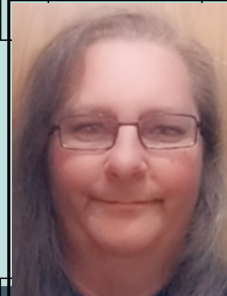
When not outdoors, Mary likes to do
