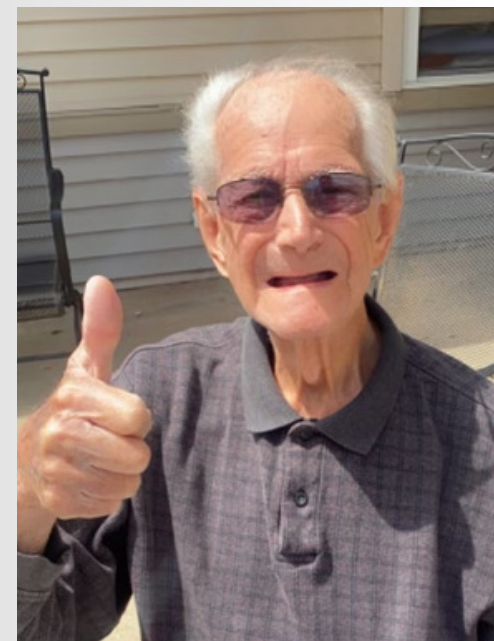

for over 25 years.

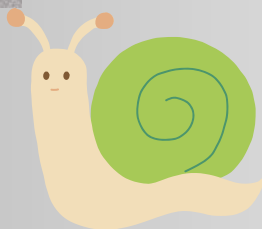
